

HARRIS CITY COUNCIL
Emergency Meeting Minutes
Monday, December 15, 2025

- I. **Call to Order:** Mayor Carlson called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m.
- II. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Everyone joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- III. **Roll Call:** City Clerk Shannon Geier conducted roll call. Present were Mayor Randy Carlson, Councilmember Al Siedow, and Councilmember Craig Moline. Councilmember Garret Pearson and Councilmember Chell Borash were absent. Geier announced a quorum was present.
- IV. **Emergency Agenda:**
 - A. **Hydraulic Cylinder for Snowplow** - The snowplow's hydraulic wing cylinder is not functioning. Robert obtained a purchase order number from the clerk and brought the equipment in for repair, initially expecting a minor fix. However, it was determined that the wing cylinder must be rebuilt at a cost of \$1,100 through Sunrise Hydraulics. Siedow motioned to fix wing cylinder. Moline seconding the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
 - B. **Water Tower Valve fix** – George contacted a plumber that was willing to do the fix. The estimate was given by Mud diggers out of Cambridge gave an estimate of \$840 they can be here on Friday 12/19 to fix it. George will start emptying the tower on Friday morning. Siedow motioned to fix valve in the water tower. Moline seconding the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
 - C. **Christmas light outlets** – The Mayor contacted Garret Electric for an estimate for fixing the outlets on the streetlights for holiday decorations. Garret Electric gave a bid for \$500 for fixing four of the streetlights that needed outlet work and one for \$500 that needs more work done to the streetlight. Moline made a motion to the streetlights using Garret Electric for \$1000. Siedow seconding the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
- V. **Adjourn:** Siedow made a motion to adjourn. Moline seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 2:38 p.m.
