Harris City Council Truth-in-Taxation Public Meeting Minutes December 9, 2024

- 1. **<u>Call to Order:</u>** Mayor Carlson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.
- 2. **<u>Pledge of Allegiance:</u>** Everyone joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. Roll Call: City Clerk Shannon Geier conducted roll call. Present were Mayor Randy Carlson, Councilmember Diane Miller, Councilmember David Maack, Councilmember Al Siedow, and Councilmember Garret Pearson. City Clerk Geier confirmed that a quorum was present.

4. Presentation of the 2025 Tax Levy Information:

- City Treasurer Sue Riesing presented the 2025 tax levy information, noting that there were no changes from the previous presentation.
- Don Cardinal inquired about the status of the 2024 budget. Treasurer Riesing reported that the projected year-end balance for the 2024 General Fund is over budget by \$57,163. The projected balances for individual departments are as follows: (plus sign = under budget; minus sign = over budget)

o Council: +\$831

Police Support: +\$554

Public Works: +\$3,371

Building/Zoning Administration: +\$2,523

o Elections: -\$350

o City Clerk: -\$4,001

o City Hall (General): -\$4,213

o Parks: -\$5,410

Fire Department: -\$50,467 No further discussion followed.

• Jim Swing raised concerns regarding tax increases on three of his parcels. Nothing has changed on any of the parcels, but the values have gone down, and the taxes have increased. Craig Moline was present and explained to Swing that property tax rates are partly determined by property classifications, such as agricultural or wetland, which are controlled by the State.
